



MCR QUALITY REVIEW PROCESS

MCR's having an effective QRP in place also benefits our customers in ways that they will be able to understand. First of all, methodology errors will be detected and corrected before extensive computational work is done, and computational errors will be detected well in advance of the final product's being submitted to the decision maker. The customer will be confident in knowing that MCR's products are developed using state-of-the-art analytic methods that enjoy wide support in the cost-analysis community.
